




#### 2017 Participant Demographics



### Early Childhood Center Outcome Achievement 2014-2017


#### **Total Participants 2015-2017**



33 out of 36 scholars obtained job readiness skills


60 out of 71 scholars maintained or improved grades and/or academic performance

70 out of 71 scholars did not become pregnant or father a child during their teen years







#### **Senior Financial Resiliency Pilot**


15 out of 16 participants met savings goal and received 2:1 match.
